Expectations & Itinerary

Week Before Legislative Day

Monday, February 24 — MDA will email registrants a packet with materials needed to prepare for attending Dental Day (and in advance of the Zoom briefing).

Wednesday, February 26 — Zoom Briefing at 7pm with MDA Lobby Team. For those unable to join, it will be available on demand and emailed. <u>Click for Zoom link.</u>

Monday, March 2 — Final materials with any updates since the Zoom briefing will be emailed to members. *These same materials will be printed and at the Capitol.*

Dental Day — Wednesday, March 5

Allow Time — The security check-in typically takes longer in the morning, so plan for the collective time it will take to arrive, park, walk to the Capitol, go through security and still be on time for check-in, gather with group and attend meetings.

Breakfast — On your own, but coffee and bottled water will be at registration table.

7:30am — Check-in begins at Capitol Third Floor Rotunda. See map. MDA staff will be there to greet you and provide name badges/folders. *You do not need to bring any printouts from emails sent from the MDA*.

7:45am — Group Picture (minus students), Third Floor Rotunda Staircase. Student Group Picture time TBD.

8–11:30am — Legislator meetings in offices begin and continue according to pre-set appointments until complete. Click to access a Legislative Roster to familiarize names and faces. Reminder: Bring your business cards!

Lunch — On your own, see restaurant suggestions.

Parking

- Parking Garage, 201 Madison Street (small fee, but suggested due to street meter limit). See map.
- Metered parking around the downtown area.
- Off Capitol grounds (two-hour limits).

Security

- Enter at the Carriage Entrance Front/lawn side of Capitol, across from Supreme Court building (preferred for easy access to Third Floor Rotunda).
