### Dear Missouri Dental Students,

The MDA Foundation Dental Scholarship Program is now open to receive applications. The MDA is committed to supporting its future member dentists. We will award up to six \$5,000 scholarships for the 2025-2026 academic year. They are competitive and will be based upon a matrix of leadership, future vision and scholarly achievement. The winners will be selected from all eligible applicants. The scholarship program is an initiative of the MDA Foundation in cooperation with the Missouri Dental Association. Applications must be postmarked (or received via email) by Friday, February 14, 2025.

### **Eligibility**

- Students must be entering their 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4th year of dental school in fall 2025.
- Students must be graduates of a Missouri high school and must have been a resident of Missouri for a minimum of five years.
- Applicants should intend to practice in the state of Missouri after graduation.
- Previous recipients of MDA Foundation Scholarships are ineligible for a second MDAF Scholarship.

Please write a short essay on how your past experience(s) have shaped your career goals to align with this vision, and how organized dentistry will aid in this goal."

#### **Essay Evaluation Criteria**

- Must not exceed 500 words
- Must be typed and single-sided
- Must be focused and well-reasoned
- Must demonstrate a clear understanding of the issue/topic
- Must demonstrate your own opinion and stance of the topic

### **Zoom Interview**

The Foundation will conduct Zoom interviews with the finalists to help with selection. You must be available during one of two evening time slots the week of March 10-14,2025. Exact dates and times TBA later. Each candidate interview will last no longer than 10 minutes.
